SUBJECT:

Consider approval and adoption of the AMENDED Groundwater Sustainability Plan For The Salinas Valley – Paso Robles Area ("Paso Basin"), Authorizing the County Director of Groundwater Sustainability to Serve as Plan Manager and Finding that the Project is Exempt from Section 21000 Et Seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA) by RESOLUTION 2022-02.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve and adopt the AMENDED Groundwater Sustainability Plan For The Salinas Valley – Paso Robles Area ("Paso Basin"), Authorizing the County Director of Groundwater Sustainability to Serve as Plan Manager and Finding that the Project is Exempt from Section 21000 Et Seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA). RESOLUTION 2022-02

BACKGROUND:

November 2019 the Board adopted resolution 2019-02 adopting the Final Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for this basin.

In 2021 the Department of Water Resources (DWR) provided a letter of deficiency to the County indicating that the GSP was deficient in two areas. Todd Groundwater was hired to make the necessary corrections to the GSP which have been made and approved by the Paso Basin Cooperative Committee (PBCC).

Changes were made to sections

- 4.7.2 HCM Groundwater Discharge (Hydrogeological Conceptual Model)
- 5.5 Groundwater Conditions ISW (Integrated Surface Water)
- 7.6 Monitoring Network-ISW Monitoring and Data Gaps
- 8.4 SMC-Chronic Lowering of Levels (Sustainable Management Criteria)
- 8.8 SMC-Depletion of ISW SMC

These changes have been reviewed by the public at the PBCC meetings as well as staff and DWR. The PBCC is confident that the revisions made satisfy the corrections from DWR.

The Original GSP sections have been amended to include the corrected information. This GSA needs to receive and file the amended GSP sections and will hold a hearing on June 23rd 2022 to adopt the full amended GSP and authorize the County of San Luis Obispo Director of Groundwater Sustainability or their designee to submit the amended GSP to DWR.

At the April 28th 2022 meeting the changes were outlined to the Board and the required Public Hearing period started.

After the public hearing ends at the June 23rd meeting the Board should approve, by resolution, the Amend GSP and authorizing the County Director of Groundwater Sustainability or their designee to submit the Amended GSP to DWR.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AMENDED 2019 GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN FOR THE SALINAS VALLEY – PASO ROBLES AREA ("PASO BASIN"), AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY DIRECTOR OF GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY TO SERVE AS PLAN MANAGER AND FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM SECTION 21000 ET SEQ. OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE (CEQA)

WHEREAS, in 2014 the California Legislature and the Governor passed into law the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) for local management of groundwater resources in California through the formation of Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) and through preparation and implementation of Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs); and

WHEREAS, three other local agencies within the Paso Basin, including the County of San Luis Obispo, the Shandon-San Juan Water District and the City of Paso Robles (said agencies and the San Miguel Community Services District GSA are collectively referred to as the "Paso Basin GSAs") decided to become GSAs within their jurisdiction, such that the service areas of the Paso Basin GSAs collectively cover the entire Paso Basin; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the options identified in Water Code Section 10727, the Paso Basin GSAs entered into a Memorandum of Agreement Regarding Preparation of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan for the Paso Robles Groundwater Basin ("MOA") for purposes of preparing a single groundwater sustainability plan ("GSP") for the Paso Basin and establishing the Paso Basin Cooperative Committee ("Committee") to conduct activities related to GSP development and SGMA implementation; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2018, in accordance with Water Code Section 10727.8 and prior to initiating development of the GSP, the Paso Basin GSAs provided to DWR, and made available to the public, a written statement ("Written Statement") describing the manner in which interested parties could participate in the development and implementation of the GSP; and

WHEREAS, since that time and consistent with the contents of the Written Statement and the requirements of Water Code Section 10723.2 and to otherwise encourage the involvement of diverse social, cultural and economic elements of the population within the Paso Basin, the San Miguel Community Services District GSA Board has considered SGMA implementation within the Paso Basin at several of its public meetings (including through regular staff updates). In addition, the Paso Basin Cooperative, has held multiple public meetings related to development of the GSP. Public outreach is part of the requirements from the State of California for preparation of an amended GSP; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Basin GSAs have jointly developed the Amended Groundwater Sustainability Plan for the Salinas Valley – Paso Robles Area ("Paso Basin GSP") in the manner described in the MOA, and the Committee adopted a motion on April 27th 2022 recommending that each of the Paso Basin GSAs adopt the Paso Basin GSP; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Sections 351((z) and 353.4 of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, the San Miguel Community Services GSA hereby appoints the San Luis Obispo County Director of Groundwater Sustainability, or designee, as the authorized representative of the San Miguel Community Services GSA to do the following on behalf of the Paso Basin GSAs: (a) submit the Paso Basin GSP to DWR

provided that each Paso Basin GSA has adopted the Paso Basin GSP; (b) to submit the Annual Reports to DWR provided that said report has been approved by the affirmative vote of sixty-seven percent of the Committee as described in Section 4.8 of the MOA and (c) to otherwise serve as the point of contact with DWR on behalf of the Paso Basin GSAs with respect the Paso Basin GSP and First Annual Report; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SAN MIGUEL COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT GSA BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The San Miguel Community Services District GSA Board hereby adopts the Amended Paso Basin GSP.

Section 3: The County Director of Groundwater Sustainability, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to submit the Paso Basin GSP to DWR and to serve as the point of contact with DWR on behalf of the County GSA and the other Paso Basin GSAs consistent with the authorization described above and the requirements contained within the GSP Regulations. Without limiting the foregoing, the County Director of Groundwater Sustainability is hereby authorized to provide to DWR all information required by SGMA and necessary for DWR's evaluation of the Paso Basin GSP thereunder, to submit Annual Reports, and to take such further actions as may be necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 4: The San Miguel Community Services District GSA Board finds that the adoption of this Resolution is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code §§ 21000 *et seq.*) (CEQA) pursuant to Water Code Section 10728.6 and Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.

SAN MIGUEL COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Miguel Community Service District (Board of Directors) will hold a public hearing to consider adopting a resolution adopting the updated Paso Robles Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (Updated GSP) and finding that the project is exempt from Section 21000 et seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA) pursuant to Water Code Section 10728.6.

Background

In 2017, the Board of Directors formed the Paso Basin – San Miguel Community Service District Groundwater Sustainability Agency (SMCSD GSA) to comply with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). The City of Paso Robles, the Shandon-San Juan Water District, and County of San Luis Obispo also formed groundwater sustainability agencies (GSAs) within their jurisdiction. The agencies (together, Paso Basin GSAs), whose service areas collectively cover the entire Paso Basin, entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), establishing the Paso Basin Cooperative Committee (Committee) for the purpose of developing a single groundwater sustainability plan (GSP) to be considered for adoption by each Paso Basin GSA and subsequently submitted to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) by the SGMA deadline of January 31, 2020 and for the purpose of continued coordination during the period of GSP adoption and DWR approval. Under the framework of the MOA, the Paso Basin GSAs engaged the public and coordinated to jointly develop the GSP which was recommended by the Committee for adoption by each of the Paso Basin GSAs. The Board of Directors held a public hearing and adopted Resolution 2016-34 adopting the GSP on November 21, 2019 and authorized the County Director of Public Works, or designee, as the Plan Manager to submit the GSP to DWR. The GSP was submitted to DWR on January 30, 2020.

On January 21, 2022, DWR announced that the GSP had received an incomplete determination under the provisions of SGMA and the Final GSP Emergency Regulations. The determination started a 180-day window to address DWR's comments. DWR found two areas of deficiency in the GSP: (1) the GSP did not include an adequate assessment of potential impacts to domestic wells associated with chronic lowering of groundwater levels, and (2) the GSP did not include an adequate assessment of the potential for depletion of interconnected surface waters. The Paso Basin GSAs initiated communications with DWR staff immediately after receipt of the initial notification and retained the services of a consultant to provide technical assistance in addressing the deficiencies. The work in addressing the deficiencies was completed and the GSP has been updated. The Committee recommended the Updated GSP for adoption by each of the Paso Basin GSAs at its April 27, 2022 meeting consistent with the terms of the MOA, and the Updated GSP sections were made available at the following link:

Should the Board of Directors decide to adopt the resolution, such action would allow the County to submit the Updated GSP and continue coordinating with the Paso Basin GSAs on GSP implementation, maintaining compliance with SGMA requirements.
